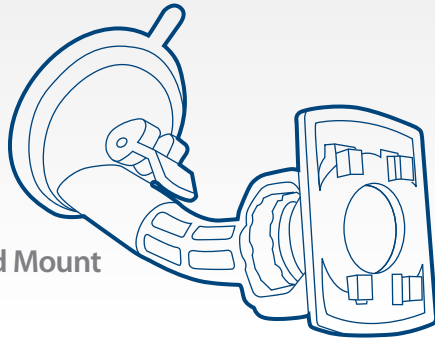
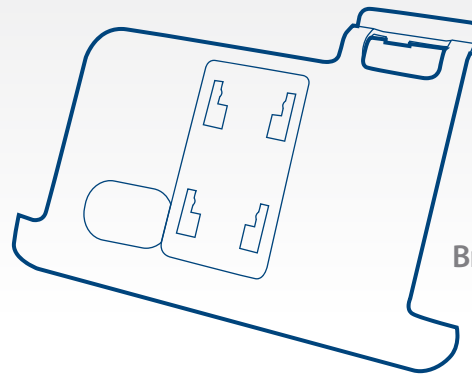


Installing the Windshield Mount for TeleNav Shotgun™

Windshield Mount



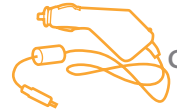
Bracket

USB Cable

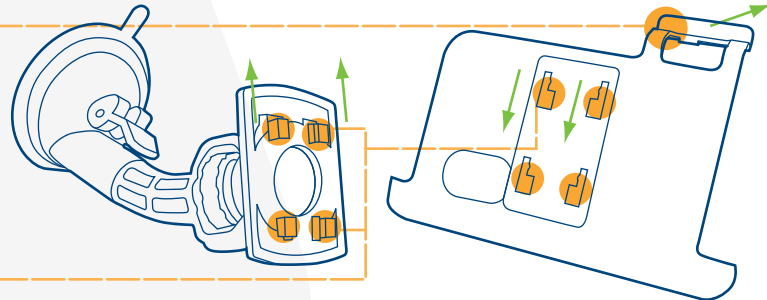


Car Charger

Please review the safety warnings on the back of this guide before installation.

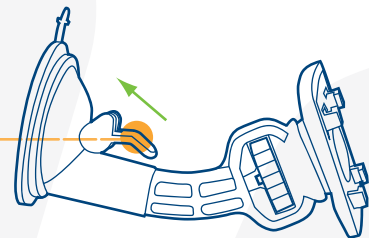
1 Attach the bracket to the windshield mount.

- Hold the bracket so that the Release Tab is on top and curves away from the windshield mount.
- Line up the four square tabs on the windshield mount and make sure they fit into the four holes on the back of the bracket.
- Slide the bracket down on the windshield mount until the parts click into place.



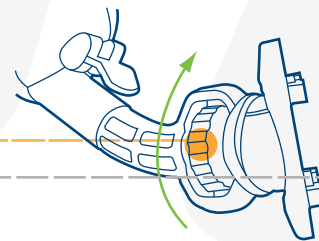
2 Attach the suction cup to your vehicle's windshield. The suction cup is tightened onto the windshield by pushing the locking lever up until it snaps into place.

NOTE: Make sure the surface of the suction cup and the windshield's surface are both clean and dry prior to mounting. In cold weather (less than 15°C/60° F), be sure your windshield is warm before attaching the suction cup. This ensures a strong suction. You may need to turn on the heat or defroster in your vehicle.



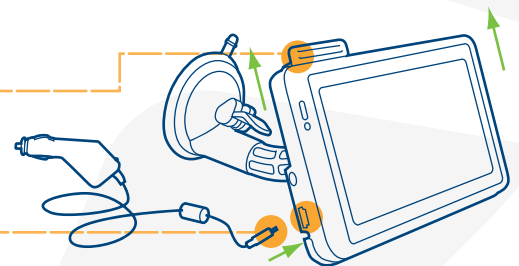
3 The bracket can be swiveled to your preferred viewing angle.

- Loosen the swivel wheel on the windshield mount by turning it clockwise.
- Rotate the bracket to your liking.
- Tighten the swivel wheel by turning it counter-clockwise.



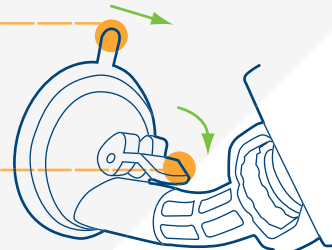
4 Insert TeleNav Shotgun into the mounting bracket. Make sure the Power button faces up and that TeleNav Shotgun clicks into the Release Tab so that it is secure.

NOTE: You may want to use the car charger while using TeleNav Shotgun in a vehicle to maximize battery life. Attach the car charger to the USB adaptor on the left side of the TeleNav Shotgun.



5 To remove the windshield suction cup, flip the locking lever back and pull the vacuum strap, the plastic tab located on the suction cup's outer edge.

WARNING: Never leave the windshield mount inside the vehicle in excessive heat. The mounting device and suction cup may be damaged if the inside temperature exceeds 70°C (160°F).

WARNING: Suction mount usage prohibited in certain states.

Obey all local laws. According to Minnesota Statutes 2005, section 169.71, drivers are prohibited from using windshield suction mounts while operating motor vehicles. Check your local and state laws and regulations for similar restrictions. In states where suction mounts are prohibited, you may want to use dashboard disk mounts. The mount must not inhibit operation of your vehicle. Ensure that it does not disturb your field of vision. Do not attach the mount close to any airbags, shifters or the steering wheel. Check that the deployment of the airbag is not blocked or impaired in any way. Ensure that the suction mount is not installed where you might come in contact with it in the event of an accident or collision. All adjustments must be done before driving. Keep all accessories and enhancements out of the reach of small children. TeleNav, Inc. is not responsible for any fines, penalties or damage that may be incurred by disregarding this notice.

Tips for Using TeleNav Shotgun

- Attach the TeleNav Shotgun device securely to the mounting arm using the enclosed bracket. Make sure the device clicks into place, as sudden bumps in the road while you are driving can cause TeleNav Shotgun to fall from its mounting bracket.
- Make sure both the suction cup and surface of your windshield are clean and dry before mounting. The suction cup may come off if you attempt to mount it to a windshield with debris or condensation.
- The suction cup may be affected by low and high temperatures or sudden changes in temperature and may come loose from its mounting location. You may want to warm up the car's interior before installing the mounting arm.
- Mount TeleNav Shotgun in an area that gives it a clear view of the sky for optimal GPS performance.
- You may want to remove TeleNav Shotgun and its mount when leaving your vehicle to prevent theft or damage from exposure to high temperature.
